

**VOTING IN THE ICC ELECTION:
EVERYONE WHO IS ON THE MEMBERSHIP LIST
BY AUGUST 13, 2018 WILL BE ELIGIBLE TO VOTE.**

The Italian Community Center Bylaws state that only “members in good standing” may vote in the ICC election.

A member in good standing for the annual election is defined as any adult who is a paid member for at least 60 days prior to the final day that a ballot can be returned and postmarked in the envelope that is sent by the Nominating Committee to every eligible voting member.

For the purposes of the upcoming election, any adult member who has renewed a membership or become a member on or before Monday, August 13, 2018 shall be considered a member in good standing.

Every member in good standing will receive the official ballot with the proper ballot return envelope in the mail within 8 days of the September General Membership Meeting. That meeting will take place on Thursday, September 20, 2018.

In order to have your vote count, you must have your ballot return envelope postmarked by no later than the Thursday before the opening and counting of the ballot and the announcement of election results. For this election, the latest that postmarked envelopes will be accepted is Thursday, October 11, 2018. Ballot envelopes will be opened and ballots will be counted during the October General Membership Meeting, which is scheduled Thursday, October 18, 2018. The election results will be announced before the adjournment of the meeting.

Any ballots received after October 11, 2018 will be saved but not opened.
