

Glitter Crowns for the Epiphany

Happy Feast of the Epiphany!

Three glittery crowns that make a **BEAUTIFUL** centerpiece for your table!



It's so simple, and it uses glitter! It can be a little messy, but it's SUCH a fun way to decorate. You have to use glitter and be messy during the holidays or it just doesn't feel like the holidays!!

So here's what you need:

- 2 toilet paper tubes
- white glue
- paint brush
- glitter
- scissors
- Use a large zip-lock bag for the glitter (to make it less messy)

Cut the toilet paper tubes in half and cut out triangle shaped wedges at the top of each half tube to make a crown shape.
You need 3 crowns for the Three Kings!



Paint white glue all over the outside of the crown.



Roll the crown in glitter until it's covered.

Put your glitter in a zip-lock bag to help keep the mess at a minimum. Spread the glitter out inside the bag and roll the crown around in it.

Knock off the extra glitter before taking it out of the bag.



That's it! You now have a shiny gold crown!

Now do it again 2 more times to make 3 crowns.



Feel free to add LED tea lights to the center and place them on your table as a centerpiece. The light will make your glitter SHINE!
